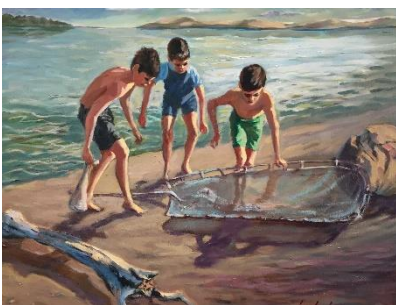


## Our Place Exhibition

When you photograph your artwork, do it on a cloudy-bright day outside to get the best light, eliminating shadows. It's easiest to put the painting on the ground, hover over it with your camera/phone, making sure the sides of the painting are parallel on the screen. Good luck!
